Congratulations! You have just purchased one of the most remarkable programs ever written! MAKE80 is unlike any other software. It will enable the owner of an 80 track disk drive to read a standard 35 or 40 track formatted diskette and rewrite it into 80 track format!

The supplied diskette contains the MAKE80 program. Insert it into your 40 or 80 track drive 0 and press reset. When the MAKE80 program is loaded, you may remove it from the drive as it is no longer needed.

NOTE: The program will initialize with a step speed of 40ms. If your drives are capable of going faster, hold down the 0,1,2 or 3 keys (for 6, 12, 20 and 40 ms respectively) while the program loads.

At this point you will be asked for the drive number which contains a mounted 35 or 40 track source disk mounted in your 80 track drive. Next you will be asked if the diskette is <S>ingle or <D>ouble density. If double, you will be asked if the sectors are numbered from 0-17 or 1-18. MAKE80 will then proceed to reformat your disk into an 80 track readable disk, and then update the directory to reflect the additional tracks.

Don't despair if you can't remember which of your diskettes are 35 tracks and which are 40 tracks. MAKE80 looks for itself!

When MAKE80 has finished, you are prompted to press <ENTER> to restart. You may do another disk at this time, or mount your operating system on drive 0 and press reset.
