You have received this package of information from Apparat, Inc., because you are a registered owner of NEWDOS/80. If you know of any registered NEWDOS/80 owners who did not receive a package, please have them call me at the number below to confirm their registration.

The enclosed information is part of our effort to provide support to the thousands of customers who have legitimately purchased and registered copies of the NEWDOS operating systems. As part of this support, a special phone line at Apparat is being dedicated to NEWDOS/80 problems. I intend to attempt to take the calls on this line personally.

Inquiries by mail are also welcome. I will try to respond to all letters as quickly as possible. Telephone calls are welcome during any of our business hours (9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., M.S.T., Monday through Friday). However, I am most readily available Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays from 12:00 noon until 4:00 p.m., M.S.T. The telephone number and address are given below.

In this package you will find information on new products from Apparat, including the latest release of NEWDOS/80, called Version 2.0. An exchange offer is explained for the current NEWDOS/80 Version 1.0 owners. Enclosed also is a form to use to place an order for exchanging Version 1.0 for Version 2.0. No orders for exchanges will be accepted without this form!

The latest ZAP sheets are also enclosed. Please examine these carefully, and note ZAP #48. I apologize for not getting these out sooner. Due to the great expense and work necessary to mass mail these, we are unable to provide them more often than about every 6 months. I am considering other methods for distribution of support information on Version 2.0. One possibility is to sell subscriptions to a monthly Apparat newsletter for NEWDOS/80 owners who need information more often. It would include Zaps, letters from users, tips on operation, new products, and other information. Please send me your ideas on how we can provide better support for our users at reasonable cost. As always Zaps are available by request, call on the phone or send a letter. If you have a particular problem, let me know and I will do my best to correct it.

In the Version 2.0 of NEWDOS/80 for Model III, we will be maintaining compatibility with TRSDOS Model I formats and directories, not TRSDOS Model III. The COPY command will allow the user to copy files from TRSDOS Model III to NEWDOS/80 disks or vice versa, but not to have TRSDOS Model III format disks on-line when the system is running. You will, however, be able to have Model I disks in the Model III on-line, while running and read or write to them. NEWDOS/80 Model III disks will run under NEWDOS/80 Model I also. Single density disks will require the running of DIRCHECK on them first, double density disks will not. How do you feel about this?

- o DOUBLE DENSITY ON MODEL I
Use the LNW DOUBLER or PERCOM DOUBLER to expand storage 80% under NEWDOS/80 Version 2.0, mixing single and double density specifications without any patches.
- o SINGLE DENSITY ON MODEL III
Will allow the MODEL III to read disks from MODEL I and to write disks the MODEL I can read, making it easy to move programs between the two under NEWDOS/80 on both machines.
- o COPY BY FILE EXPANDED
CBF will now work with system files and can run on single drive systems. Files to be copied can be limited to files of common extension or only non-invisible files. Files for copying can be listed in a data file. This is helpful in moving programs from NEWDOS/80 Version 1.0 system disks to NEWDOS/80 Version 2.0.
- o EXPANDED DIRECTORIES
Directories can be expanded three times the normal number of available entries, even on DOS disks. This is extremely useful when using double density.
- o DYNAMICALLY MERGE IN BASIC
To allow sections of BASIC programs to be deleted and replaced during program execution with files from the disk. Also allows merging of non-ASCII format files.
