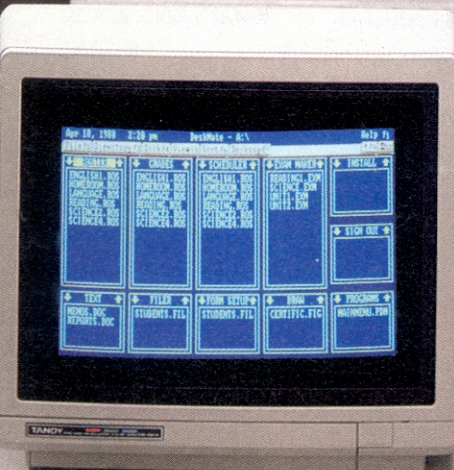

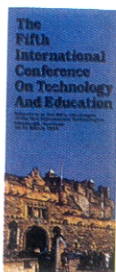

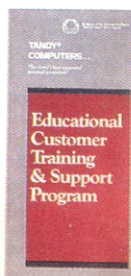
Meeting of the Minds
