Detailed Description

The In-memory Information System consists of three programs:

Initialization — This program sets up your file structure. It is used to create your initial data tape.

Sort — This program sorts your information into alphabetic or numeric order.

Update & Retrieval — allows you to look at, delete, change, or add to your data. After changes are made you create a new data tape.
