Problem

There have been problems reported in General Ledger hanging up while posting. The problem has been found to deal with the GLJOUR file.

Solution

Three things can cause this problem to occur.

1. Foreign programs on the disk will cause file allocation problems. Do not put any extra files on the program or data diskettes.
2. BASICR - is on the disk. This file should be killed off. To do this, at DOS READY type KILL BASICR/CMD.BASIC.
3. There should be at least 9 free granules on the program disk after construction of the CTRL file (after setup) and before construction of the GLJOUR file (during posting).

There is a change the user can make to allow the file allocation to be more dynamic. If the user wishes to place other files on the disk, the number of transactions allowed will be reduced by 30 for every granule used. In no case should the user take up more than 4 granules. To do this follow these steps

1. Backup the diskette(s) and make the changes on the Backup copy of the program.
2. In BASIC load the program by typing LOAD"GLTXPOST".
3. Make the following corrections:

CHANGES (Retype the line or refer to the Edit section of the owners manual)

Old Line: 302 PUT2,ME:ME=ME+10:GOTO302

New Line: 302 PUT2,ME:ME=ME+ 5:GOTO302

Old Line: 304 IFERR<>122THENRESUME:ELSEME=(ME-30)*6:RESUME305

New Line: 304 IFERR<>122THENRESUME:ELSEME=(ME*6)-6:RESUME305

4. Type SAVE"GLTXPOST" to save the changes in the program.
5. At TRSDOS Ready, make a backup copy of the corrected diskette.
