Problem

When getting an Error Code 64 or any other signs of a crashed index the following solution could help if the problem is only in the index.

Solution

1. Backup both diskettes.
2. Place both program and data disk in computer.
3. At DOS Ready type in BASIC and then press <ENTER> for both questions - Memory Size? and How many files?
4. Now type in LOAD "DATASORT"
5. Change Line 80

Old Line: 80 FOR X=1TON:INPUT#1,V(X):NEXT:CLOSE1

New Line: 80 FOR X=1TON:V(X)=X:NEXT:CLOSE1

6. Type in SAVE"DATASORT"
7. Type in RUN"ICS"
8. At the main menu choose the first option to add an item-then add fictitious item (for example put everything in as zeroes)
9. Now go back to the main menu - At this point the data will be forced into a sort.
10. At the Main Menu choose the last option to exit the program.
11. Type in LOAD"DATASORT"
12. Change Line 80 Back to what it originally was. As follows:
80 FORX=1TON:INPUT#1,V(X):NEXT:CLOSE1
13. Type in SAVE"DATASORT"
14. Now type RUN"ICS" and delete the fictitious item that was added to force the sort.
15. This completes the changes and everything should work now.
