Problem

When a hard hyphenated word (e.g. mother-in-law) is split during Hyphenation, the end of line code embedded in text is lost when the text is reformatted or recalled. This can cause an unwanted wrap.

Solution

The following patches will fix the problem for SCRIPSIT 2.0 and 2.1.

This patch should be done on your master SCRIPSIT 2.0 or 2.1 diskette:

PATCH SCRIPSIT A=D5C2 F=00000000000000000000 C=3DCADBE12100E0C3E0E1

This patch should be done on your master Spelling and Hyphenation Dictionary diskette:

PATCH SCRIPSIT/HYP A=E1DD F=2100E0 C=C3C2D5

Both of the following patches should be done on your master SCRIPSIT diskette with the dictionary installed:

PATCH SCRIPSIT A=D5C2 F=00000000000000000000 C=3DCADBE12100E0C3E0E1

PATCH SCRIPSIT/HYP A=E1DD F=2100E0 C=C3C2D5
