Problem

The current version operates on TRSDOS-HD with one exception. The "Directory" option (to list the available data files) will not accept drive numbers greater than 3. There are program modifications available to allow the "Directory" option for Drives 4-7.

These line changes are required for use on hard disk.

Solution

The problem is corrected by following the steps listed below.

1. Backup the diskette(s) and make the changes on the Backup copy of the program.
2. In BASIC load the program by typing LOAD"DFILE/BAS".
3. Make the following corrections:

CHANGES (Retype the line or refer to the Edit section of the owners manual)

Old Line: 13000 CLS:INPUT "DIRECTORY OF FILES ON WHICH
DISK DRIVE (0-3) ";J%

New Line: 13000 CLS:INPUT "DIRECTORY OF FILES ON WHICH
DISK DRIVE (0-7) ";J%

Old Line: 13010 IFJ%<0ORJ%>3THEN1300

New Line: 13010 IFJ%<0ORJ%>7THEN13000ELSESYSTEM"DIR"+STR\$(J%):GOTO13060

If the Model II is operating under TRSDOS-HD, attempting to read the directory of Drives 0-3 will result in an ERROR 39 (an illegal input/output attempt). Floppy diskette access for the DIR command is not permitted under TRSDOS-HD. You may delete lines 13020-13050 (optional).

4. Type SAVE"DFILE/BAS" to save the changes in the program.
5. At TRSDOS READY, make a backup copy of the corrected diskette.
