PROFILE PLUS III gives the power, but not the storage capacity of PROFILE PLUS for the MODEL II. Like the MODEL II version, PROFILE PLUS III supports files with up to 99 fields per record, of which as many as 36 can be used for sorts and searches.

Up to five different user-defined data entry screens are available, and their format is determined by you, the user. Also, when you lay out the format of your data screens, you can determine the type of data that will be entered, using any of the following formats:

Alphanumeric	Numeric	Decimal (dollars & cents)
Protected	Date	Alpha must fill
Decimal must fill	Date must fill	Date last update

The dates may be either American or Australian format. The "must fill" means that when you reach that point you MUST FILL in information, the computer will not go on to the next question until you do.

By using more than one screen you can have a field that can be examined by anyone, but the information cannot be changed if you do not know the password, or you can even have files that are not visible without the password.

PROFILE PLUS III allows you to define up to five report formats and five mailing label type formats. A complete math package lets you define up to 16 math formulas. The results are stored in fields of the record. You also have the ability to change the math formulas for a file and to recalculate every field in the file.

In addition to all the features of PROFILE PLUS, several additional ones are available on the MODEL III. These include:

The records themselves can be anywhere from one to 1020 characters in length (the Model II version is restricted to 853 characters).

The searchable portion, or KEY segment, can be from one to 255 characters long (Model II version is always 85 characters long)


Mass recalculate, hardcopy, purge and delete functions are supported, only mass recalculate is available on Model II.

The powerful 16 field search ability found in the Model II version has been extended to work with report and label programs, allowing you to sort more records and faster.

The catalog number for MODEL III PROFILE PLUS will be 260-1592, at a suggested retail of \$249.95. Since PROFILE PLUS III is a totally new programme for the MODEL III, no upgrade is available for current users of the current Model III Profile (260 1562).

### PREFIX CHANGE FOR COMPUTER MERCHANDISE

As of 1st May the catalogue number prefix for all computer merchandise will change from "269" to "260".

All advertising after the May flyer will show 26 as the prefix as will all decks from Data Processing. Current decks in the system showing 269 will be accepted. This change will eliminate the bottleneck of relabeling and allow you to get the stock in your stores faster than in the past.

All your orders sent to the Warehouse after May 1st must have the new prefix.

One exception to the above will be the MODEL I disk drive 1, 2 or 3. The catalogue number for this SKU will be 261-1161 - \$479.00 suggested retail.

Catalogue number 260-1161 will be the new MODEL III external disk drive 3 - which is due in the Warehouse early in May.
